Attendance, Punctuality and Preparation

Students:

- Must wear **FULL SCHOOL UNIFORM**.
- Must arrive at the exam venue at least **20 minutes before** the starting time for each exam.
- **Cannot leave the exam room during the first hour of the exam, or during the last 15 minutes of the exam (except in an emergency).**
- **Traffic conditions** will not be accepted as a valid excuse for lateness to an exam.
- Must read the exam timetable accurately, misreading the exam timetable and information will not be accepted as a valid excuse for non-attendance.
- Must ensure that they have prepared for the exam in terms of toilet visits*, food and beverages.
*Use of the toilet during an exam will require the signing of a register.
- The following items are prohibited and **must not** be brought into the exam: **mobile phones, smart-watches and other electronic devices including headphones. These devices are to be stored in your bag and switched OFF.**
- Are responsible for bringing and maintaining their own calculator. Students may use only NESAs approved calculators.
- May not use electronic translators / dictionaries.
- Must equip themselves with exam requirements such as adequate supplies of pens, pencils, erasers, staplers, rulers, etc. Non-transparent pencil-cases are not allowed, transparent pencil-cases are accepted.
- Students with blue cards are to sit at the front of the hall.
- **Disability Provisions (DisP)** - students receiving disability provisions are to report to Mr. Burke.

Throughout the course of the exam

Students:

- Must follow the supervisors' instructions throughout the exam.
- Must follow all rules laid down for the exam. Failure to do so, or cheating will result in student removal from the exam room.
- Must make a serious attempt in all exams – a non-serious attempt will result in a zero score.
- Must abide by the 'pens down' command.
- Must use only blue or black pen unless specifically instructed.
- Must NOT:
 - eat or drink during the exam (a clear bottle of water IS permitted).
 - speak to anyone other than the supervisors.
 - disturb another student.
 - take items besides those listed on the equipment list into the exam room.
 - take anything from the exam room other than personal equipment.
- Are to respect the right of others to complete their examinations without interruption or distraction.
- Work completed during examinations must be reviewed at least once to check for mistakes and extend/add details to your responses.

Absences and misadventure

Students:

- Must follow the procedures outlined in the Assessment booklet.
- Who miss an exam for any reason must report immediately to the Deputy Principal to obtain a **Student Misadventure Appeal Form**.
- Who are claiming misadventure must provide written evidence, such as a doctor's certificate, on the day they return to school, that is, the next day you attend school.
