












From the Principal




Sporting grant for RBHS golfer



Dear Parent/Caregiver,

Randwick Boys' High School prides itself on the opportunities it provides to all of its students to reach their potential, to understand their worlds and to reflect on their experiences.

On **Thursday 21st November**, we will be participating in The Colour Run in order to raise funds for our local women's shelter, Bayside. This initiative is part of a three year commitment Randwick Boys' Year 10 cohort has made to raise much needed funds for the shelter in order to resource the centre. Our Year 10 students have participated in the *Walk the Talk* training day, run by Enlighten Education, and this is our first initiative to support the work of the our local refuge in a meaningful way whilst also fostering individual and collective wellbeing at Randwick Boys' High School.

It is our responsibility to seek permission for your child to participate in the School Colour Run.

All measures have been taken to ensure that this event is safe for all students. There will be various colour powder stations throughout the course as students complete laps of the school oval being blast with colour!

The volunteers will do their best to throw the powder at the torso, however wind and other factors can cause the powder to protrude on the face. For this reason, included in the cost of registration is a pair of protective sunglasses.

The colour powder used in the event is non-toxic, biodegradable and environmentally friendly consisting of 98% corn starch and 2% food colouring. It will likely washout of your son's clothing, however we recommend that your son brings to school a white shirt that you don't mind being coloured. That's what the event is all about! Based on the toxicology profiles of the powders used, their concentrations in the formulation and the mode of use of the products poses a low level of toxicology risk. The product is considered safe for use.

For those parents and guardians who consent for their child to participate in the event, DON'T FORGET to bring a white shirt and a towel to school before the event. It is also essential that students bring a bandanna or face mask to protect their mouth during the run and that they are wearing enclosed shoes.

Get ready for a BLAST OF COLOUR and thanks in advance for your support! Happy fundraising!

2019 School Vaccination Program

Third and Final Visit

Friday 15th November 2019

Dear Parent/ Caregivers,

On **Friday, 15**th **November**, the South Eastern Sydney Public Health Unit, will be at Randwick Boys' High School offering **Year 7, 8 and 10 students** the following **vaccinations**;

Year 7 all Students

- Human Papillomavirus Vaccine (HPV) Dose 2.
- Catch up HPV Dose 1 for students who missed Visit 1 or Visit 2 this year.
- Catch- up Diphtheria Tetanus & Pertussis (dTpa) 1 dose only for students who missed Visits 1 & 2.

Year 8 students (catch-up only):

 For those who have not completed a second Dose of the HPV course that commenced at school in Year 7 in 2018.

Year 10 Students:

 Meningococcal ACWY - 1 Dose. Meningococcal ACWY for students who missed the vaccination in term 2, 2019.

If you have begun the Vaccination Program the nurses have your son's vaccination cards (Years 7 & 8).

If your son has NOT received any vaccinations, including the Meningococcal vaccination and has NOT begun the School Vaccination Program at Randwick Boys' High School, he can begin the program on 15th November. Your son will need to collect a consent form from Ms Cassar.

Please to complete the consent form and have your son **return the Consent Form to the Front Office by Friday 8**th **November**.

The clinic will be operating in the school hall, from 9am-1pm.
