




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From the Deputy Principal

Winter sport trials began this week and will continue for the next few weeks in the lead-up to the beginning of our winter sport season.





We are committed to the safety of all students. Please ensure that your son is aware of and observes bicycle safety when riding to and from school.




























Year 10 Marine Tank Set-up Stage 1 Design & Construction

All students received The School Photographer envelope during roll call this week. The envelope provides all the relevant information regarding packages, orders and payment.


Payment options:
