The envelope provides all the relevant information regarding packages, orders and payment.


Payment options:

The second is our popular effective parenting seminar/course commencing Monday May 20th. The effective parenting course is designed for parents with children aged 10-17, who want practical, effective information and strategies to build stronger parent-child relationships and better manage and understand adolescent behaviour. 
