












From the Principal


Senior Music Night




7, 11 and 12 Parent/Teacher evening Tuesday 2nd July 4.30 – 7pm

Procedures for students transferring to a new High School

Prior to leaving and transferring to a new high school:

Parents:

Notify in writing or by email that the student is leaving RBHS. State the student's name, academic year, date of leaving and name of their new high school.

Pay for elective subjects and school contribution.

Student:

Officially 'clears' from our school by signing out from his class and completing a clearance form.

Return all RBHS text books and library books (payment is due if books are not returned).




Randwick Boys' High School 2019 Parent/Teacher Evening Online Bookings

Randwick Boys' High School has moved the Parent/Teacher booking system online.


Parents will be required to make bookings online via Sentral.


2. Using the email address you provided when you initially registered, sign in to the Student and Parent Portal.




3. Select the Interview tab.



4. Your son's classes and teachers will be displayed. Select a time slot under the <u>Appointment Time</u> column on the top right.


Once you have selected your appointments times click <u>Confirm Appointments</u> on the bottom right. Please note: you have 10 minutes to finalise your bookings.

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

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Australian Mathematics Competition Thursday 1 August

Dear Parent

The <u>Australian Mathematics Competition (AMC)</u> has been held annually since 1978. Your child is invited to enter this internationally recognised competition.

One of the largest annual events on the Australian education calendar, the AMC was the first competition of its kind in Australia and is now one of the largest of its type in the world. More than 30 countries participate each year.

The competition aims to be accessible to all students from years 3 to 12, not just the mathematically gifted. There is an emphasis on problem solving, a valuable life skill, and the questions are designed to be fun for the student. The AMC consists of five separate papers, each with 30 questions in the Middle Primary (years 3 and 4), Upper Primary (years 5 and 6), Junior (years 7 and 8), Intermediate (years 9 and 10) and Senior (years 11 and 12) divisions. Time allowed is 60 minutes for the primary papers and 75 minutes for the secondary papers.

The AMC is run by the not-for-profit Australian Maths Trust (AMT). The problems created for AMC papers are set to the highest possible standards by volunteer teams of the most experienced mathematics teachers and academics in the country.

To enter the Australian Mathematics competition you need to pay exactly \$6 to the front office before Thursday the 20th of June.
