Teaching RBHS since 1995, HT Science since 2011. Science syllabus is taught in stages, reflected in scope and sequence. Faculty have purchased textbook but still searching for appropriate texts for cohort literacy levels. Recommend BYOD. Bought data probe. Moving to make teaching as student centred as possible. Been using Kahoot for quizzes in Science. Google classroom also being used.

13 senior classes currently. Senior Science a new flexible ATAR course which students have selected for next year.

Trialling VALID online exam. On- site training for staff.

40% from previous year 8 cohort were in top 2 levels, 29% in top two levels for Working Scientifically. Whole staff team have done online training for science literacy

Competitions offered but expensive. ICAS, one year 12 student got a high distinction and came first in NSW and ACT.

Planning more excursions. Year 8 undertaking project based program in partnership with UNSW
