*President's Report*

The 3<sup>rd</sup> annual trivia night was held last Saturday and was a resounding success. The event is gaining momentum and was held in the gym for the first time. The number of people present filled the gym as opposed to last year in the hall where there were a number of empty spaces. All attending had a great time and we look forward to 2017 being bigger and better. There were just under 100 people in attendance.

Adrianna asked for feedback on the new host as this years host was different to last years. Most agreed that this years host was a little more distant and that the previous host had been more engaging. There was also some discussion on how to reduce the work load of setting up with more assistance prior to the night however Adrianna feels it all needs to be done on the day as there are a number of last minute items that come in and decisions need to be made on the morning.

The new RBHS P&C logo is now in circulation. This logo was voted on by the Executive and will now be used on all future correspondence and advertising.

The \$45k grant has been received and funds are now in our account. There was a delay in receiving the funds due to an error with the bsb number. We are now awaiting quotes on resurfacing one court. There was a suggestion that the P&C speak to Bruce Notley Smith with regards to the funding shortfall however a second grant application is already underway as we are eligible to apply to the same fund again this year to fund the resurfacing of the second court.

Transurban have opened applications for grants and Birgit has completed and submitted an application for \$3000.

The P&C Federation has sent a certificate of currency. Our insurance policy expires soon however we have until November to pay. The figure/quote for renewal is expected to be available at the next meeting.

The Bunnings Mascot BBQ has not been taking bookings for later in the year until now. Antonella to contact soon. Mitre 10 had only one vacant spot on 17thDec. Alex Luxford is willing to operate the BBQ on this date however most other people are not available.

Australian Front Line Services specialising in security for trivia nights, school dances and parties has approached the P&C with flyers and an offer to come and talk at a P&C meeting. They seemed reasonable and plausible and offer tips to parents and students on security measures as well as services.

There was been a suggestion that the meeting time of 7.30pm is too late. After some discussion it was unanimously agreed to start at 7pm for future meetings.
